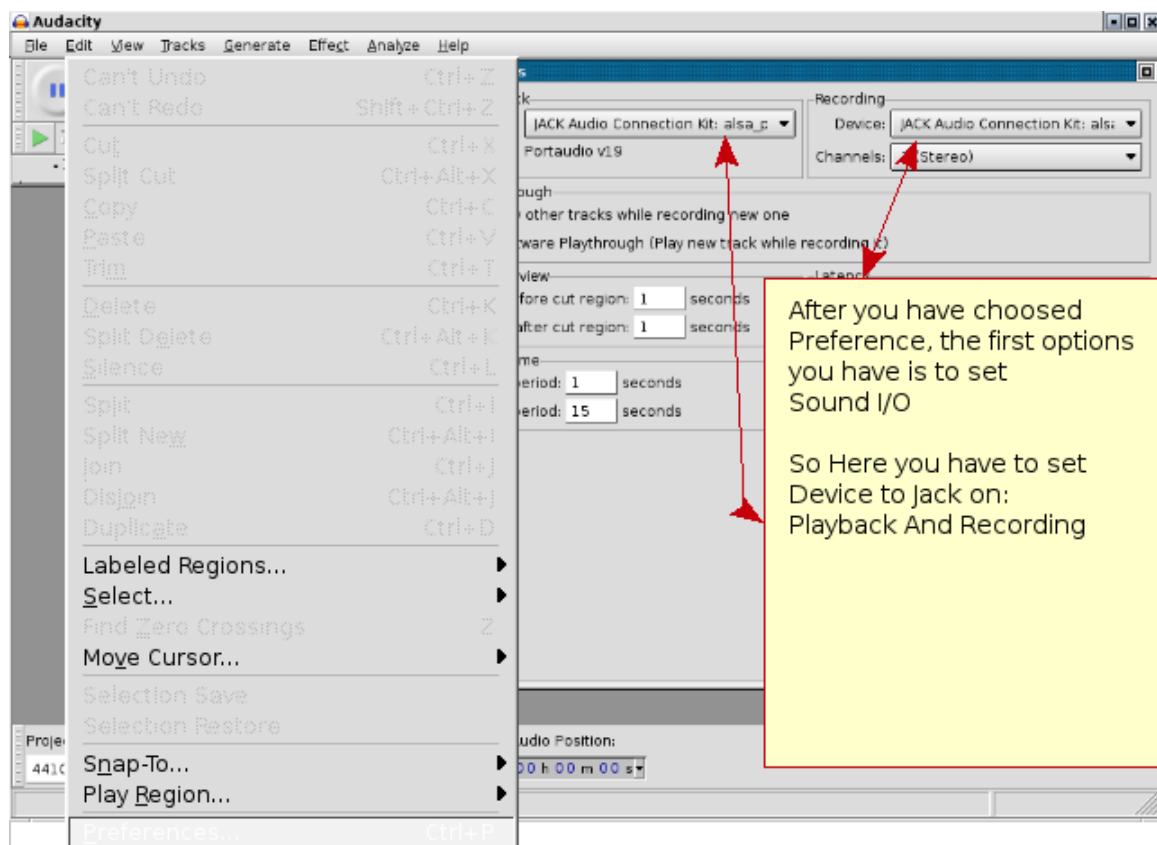
2 はじめる前に

Audacity のセットアップは Jack を使えば難しくはありません。Jack は他のプログラムと音声機能を同時に使えるようにします。Jack 自体のセットアップも難しくありません。次のガイドをご参照ください:

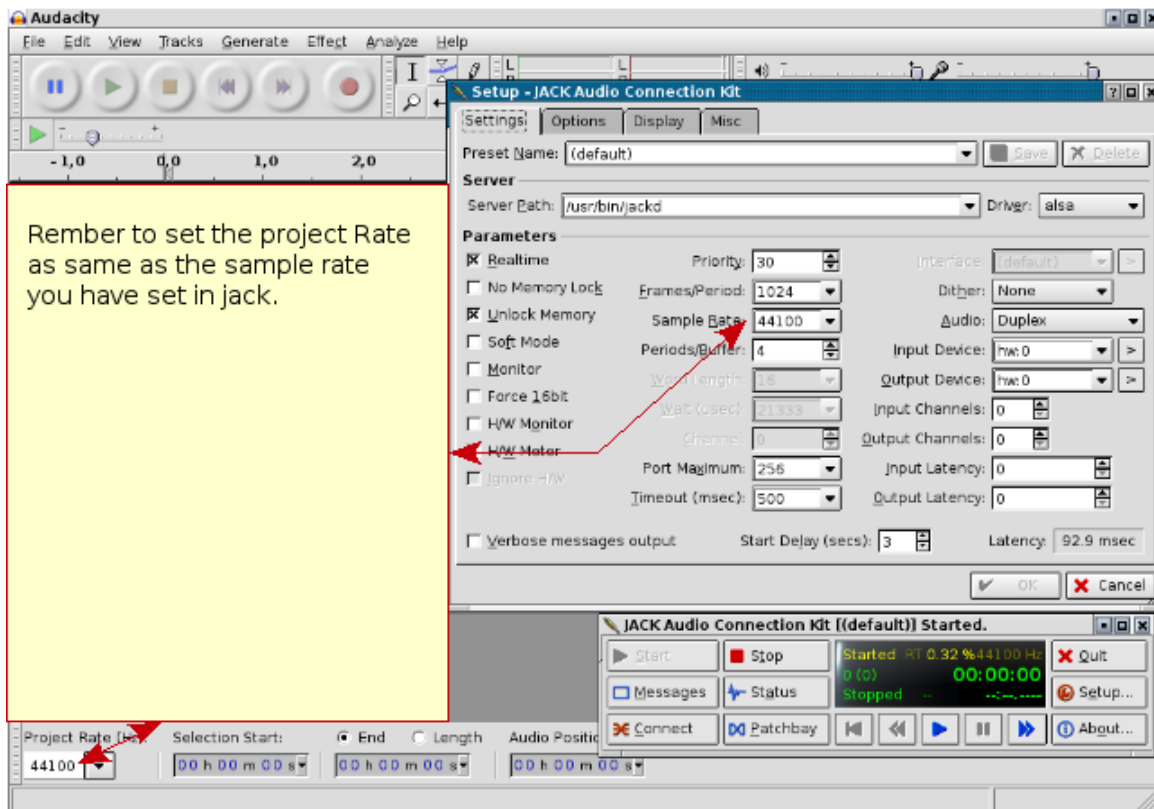

Audacity で Jack を使うには、メニューから --> Edit ---> Preferences を選びます。



プロジェクトで利用するサンプリングレートは Jack のものと同じにありません。

3 録音してみる

録音するときには、まず録音音量の設定に注意してください。高すぎるとよくありません。録音音量は高めよりも低めがよいです。



録音で音が割れないようにするためには、ノーマライズを利用して自動的に録音音量を設定します。

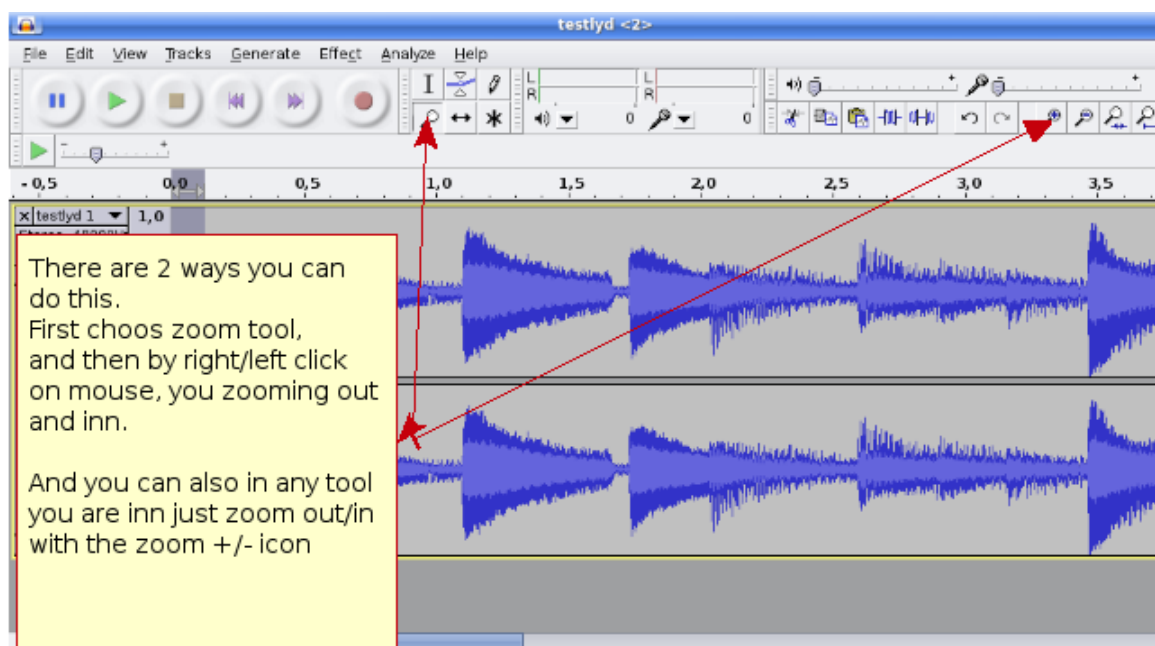


ノーマライズした後はこうなります。

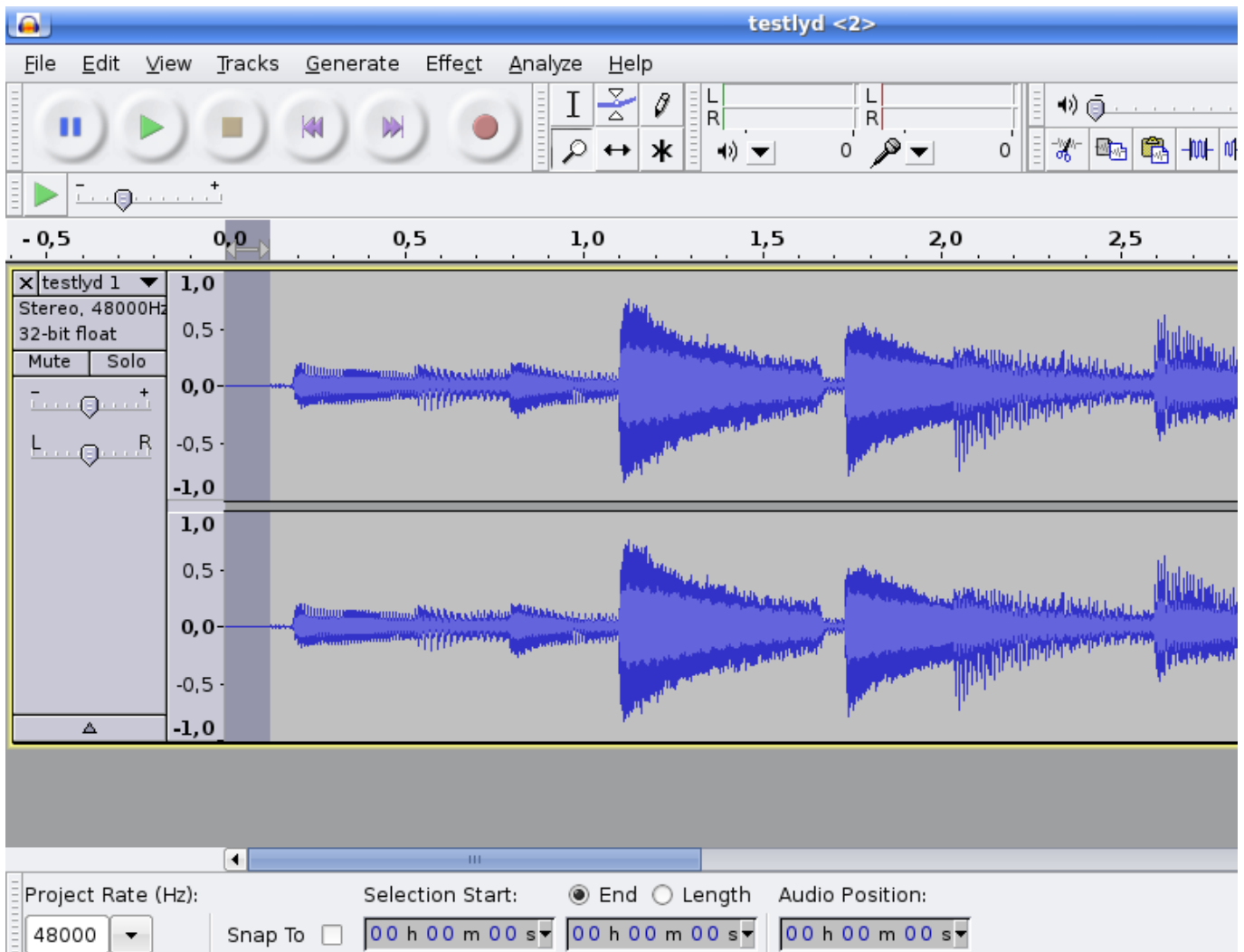


録音部位の音量が調整できました。音割れを防ぐには、低めで録音してから Audacity に後で調整させるのがよいでしょう。次はマイクの背景ヒス音などのノイズの除去をしてみましょう。まず録音トラックで除去したい「ノイズプロフィール」を設定します。

1. まずズームアウトして録音全体が見えるようにします。



2. 次にノイズ部位をマークします。マウスの左ボタンを押し続けて、ドラッグして部位を選択します。



3. 次に「ノイズ除去」を選びます。



そして「ノイズプロフィール」を作成します。



5. CTRL + A で全体を選択し、メニューからノイズ除去を再度選んで、OK を押します。

反響音などを除去したいなど、その他のエフェクトを利用するには、インストール時に推奨したプラグインたちをメニューから探してみてください。

作成した録音データの保存には WAV、AIFF、MP3、OGG、FLAC 形式が利用できます。ファイルメニューで選択してください。

4 音声のインポート

Audacity を用いれば様々な形式の音声をインポートできます。音声入力、MIDI、レコードレーベル、それに生の波形データなどからインポートできますし、MP3 ファイルも直接プロジェクトにインポートできますので、複数の曲のミックスも可能です。

試してみましょう。

まず私の十八番の "smurfesangen" を、そして次にミキシングしたいものをインポートしていきます。メニューの「File」から「Import Audio」で追加していけば、トラックが下に追加されていきます。ミキシングはかなり自由で大量にできます。



5 ツールについて

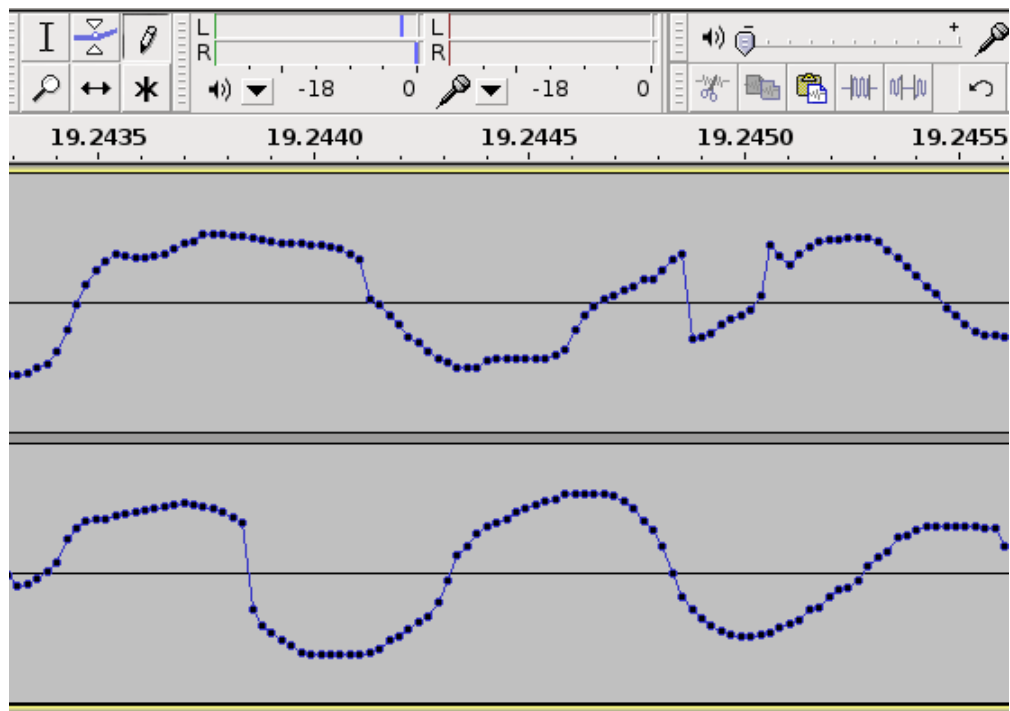


5.1 選択ツール

例えば部分的に音を分割して移動させたい場合などは、まず選択ツールで対象部位を選びます。次に「Ctrl + I」で分割します。そしてタイムシフトツールで対象部位を動かします。

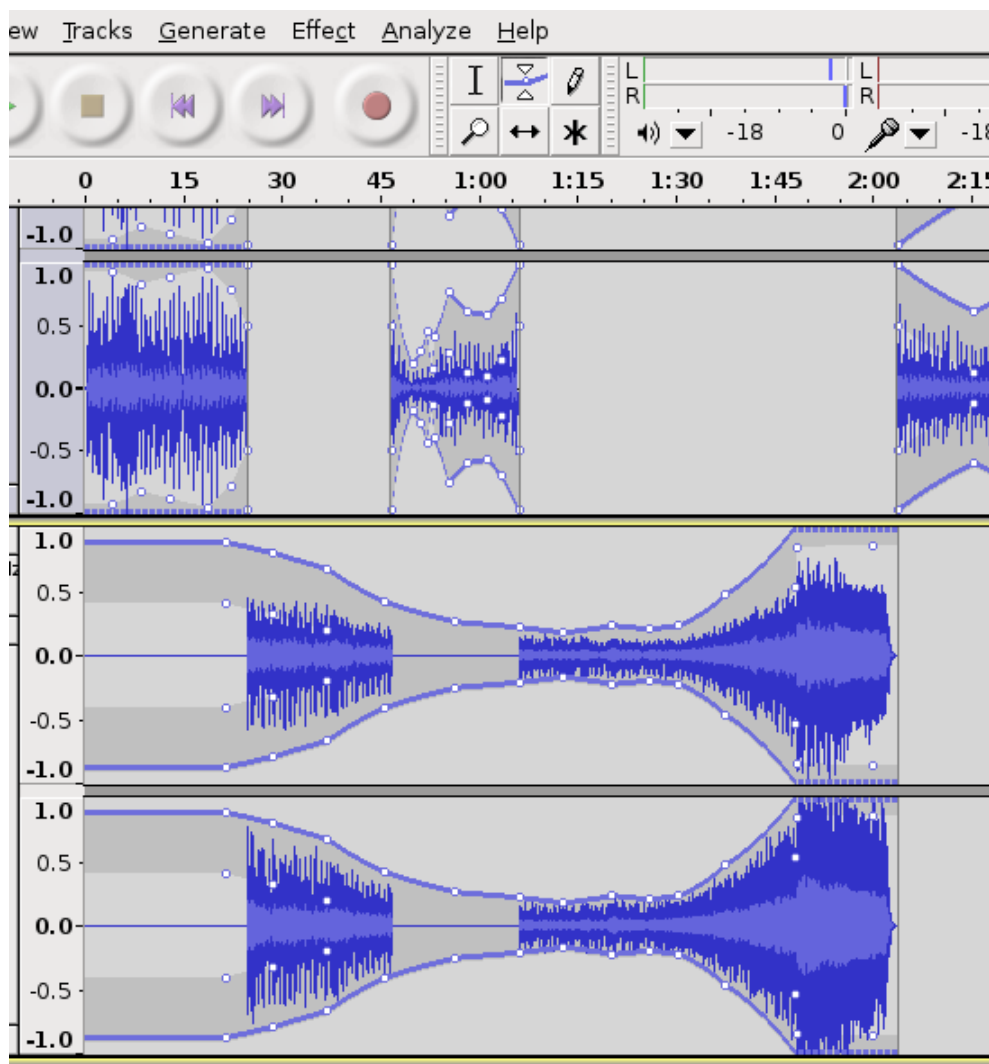
5.2 拡大ツール

拡大ツールを用いれば特定の部位の波形を編集もできます。



5.3 エンベロープツール

エンベロープツールを使えば任意の部位で音量を上げたり下げたりできます。



5.4 タイムシフトツール

特定部位の音を移動させることができます。

8.1 PO ファイルによる翻訳について

翻訳成果を commit するには Salsa で `debian-edu` にご参加ください。

その後は `debian-edu-doc` のソースコードは ssh を用いてチェックアウトできます: `git clone git@salsa.debian.org:debian-edu-doc`

翻訳のみであれば一部分のファイルを Git から (匿名で) チェックアウトする方法もあります。バグ報告として `debian-edu-doc` パッケージに PO ファイルを添付し、[バグレポート](#) に投稿してください。詳細は [バグ報告の方法](#) をご覧ください。

`debian-edu-doc` ソースを匿名でチェックアウトするには以下のコマンドをご利用ください (git パッケージのインストールが必要です):

- `git clone https://salsa.debian.org/debian-edu/debian-edu-doc.git`

その後は `documentation/debian-edu-audacity/debian-edu-audacity-manual.$CC.po` (`$CC` はあなたの言語コードに置換してください)。翻訳に利用できるツールは多数あります; おすすめは `lokalize` です。

翻訳後は (権限があれば) 直接 Git に commit してもいいですし、バグレポートとして送信して頂いても大丈夫です。

リポジトリのローカルコピーを最新に更新するには `debian-edu-doc` ディレクトリで次を実行します:

- `git pull`

まずは `/usr/share/doc/debian-edu-doc/README.debian-edu-audacity-manual-translations` をご覧になって、PO ファイルの作り方 (存在していない場合) や翻訳の更新の方法をご確認ください。

このマニュアル自体はまだ開発途上なので、「FIXME」の項目は翻訳しないでください。
